**January 9, 2024
MINUTES**

The Town of Greenback Board of Mayor and Aldermen held a regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, at the Greenback Community Center in Greenback, TN.

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dewayne Birchfield at 7:00 PM.

ROLL CALL

Upon Roll Call, the following Board members were PRESENT: Derrick Doehler, Tina Baker, Linda Black, Delmar Davis and Dewayne Birchfield. (5/0)

Thereupon, Mayor Dewayne Birchfield announced the presence of a quorum.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Doehler made a motion to adopt the January 9, 2024 Board Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded by Alderman Davis.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Black made the motion that the December 12, 2023 Board Meeting Minutes be accepted and approved as written. The motion was seconded by Alderman Baker.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED unanimously.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Financial Statement for the month of December 2023 was presented to the Board for review of monthly revenue and expenditures. Alderman Black made the motion that the December 2023 Financial Statement be accepted as presented. The motion was seconded by Alderman Doehler.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following Board members voted AYE: Baker, Davis, Birchfield, Doehler and Black

BOARD COMMENTS

Alderman Doehler acknowledge all the volunteers that helped move items into the new museum. He also stated he has enjoyed serving the citizens of Greenback this past year. Alderman Black asked if the museum carpentry was finished and received confirmation that it was. The museum is now officially ready for occupancy.

OLD BUSINESS

There was a second reading of Ordinance NO. 23-5 to ratify, confirm and adopt the zoning of property previously annexed into town. Included in the ordinance was Exhibit A stipulating all the properties associated with the annexation. Alderman Davis made a motion to accept the Ordinance as written. Alderman Doehler seconded the motion.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following Board members voted AYE: Baker, Black, Birchfield, Doehler and Davis.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 24-01-09 was presented to the Board. The Resolution adopts minimum training standards for firefighters set in Tennessee Code Annotated section 4-24-112. Alderman Davis made a motion to accept Resolution 24-1-09. The motion was seconded by Alderman Baker.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following Board members voted AYE: Black, Birchfield, Doehler, Davis and Baker.
