2-101. <u>Creation</u>. Under the provisions of <u>Tennessee Code Annotated</u>, § 11-24-301(b)(1), there is hereby established a recreation board. The board shall consist of three (3) persons, serving without pay, who shall be appointed by the mayor. Their term of office shall be for five (5) years or until their successors are appointed and qualified. Vacancies in the board occurring otherwise than by expiration of term shall be filled by the mayor for the unexpired term. (Ord. #25, July 1975, modified)

2-102. <u>Officers</u>. Immediately after their appointment, they shall meet and organize by electing one (1) of their members chairman and other officers as may be necessary. The board shall have the power to adopt bylaws, rules, and regulations for the proper conduct of public recreation, for the city. (Ord. #25, July 1975, modified)

2-103. <u>Purpose and duties</u>. The committee shall act as the advisory committee for future planning of recreation, ongoing programs, special events, and other matters related to leisure services for the citizens. The committee shall recommend special events, parades, and tourism events to the governing body. It shall have the power to conduct, or to cooperate with other agencies in conducting, any form of recreation that will employ the leisure time of the people in a constructive and wholesome manner.

2-104. <u>Budgets and solicitations</u>. Annually the board shall submit a budget to the city governing body for its approval. The board may also solicit or receive any gifts or bequests of money or other personal property or any donation to be applied, principal or income, for either temporary or permanent use for playgrounds or other recreation purposes. 2-105. <u>Annual reports</u>. The recreation board shall make full and complete annual reports to the governing body of the city and other reports from time to time as requested. (Ord. #25, July 1975)
