CHAPTER 1

POLICE DEPARTMENT

SECTION

6-101. County sheriff's department to enforce municipal ordinances.

6-101. <u>County sheriff's department to enforce municipal</u> <u>ordinances</u>. The Sheriff's Department of Loudon County shall enforce the municipal ordinances of the city according to the terms of the agreement entered into between the city and the County of Loudon, the Sheriff's Department of the County of Loudon, and the Loudon County Court of General Sessions, pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, §§ 8-8-201(34), 12-9-104 and 16-15-501.¹

CHAPTER 2

ARREST PROCEDURES

SECTION

6-201. When police officers to make arrests.

6-201. <u>When police officers to make arrests</u>.¹ Unless otherwise authorized or directed in this code or other applicable law, an arrest of the person shall be made by a police officer in the following cases:

(1) Whenever he is in possession of a warrant for the arrest of the person.

(2) Whenever an offense is committed or a breach of the peace is threatened in the officer's presence by the person.

(3) Whenever a felony has in fact been committed and the officer has probable cause to believe the person has committed it.
