MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dewayne Birchfield at 7:00pm.

ROLL CALL

Upon Roll Call, the following Board members were PRESENT: Delmar Davis, Derrick Doeher, Linda Black, Tina Baker and Dewayne Birchfield.

Thereupon, Mayor Dewayne Burchfield declared the presence of a quorum.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Black made a motion to adopt the October 14, 2025 Board Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded by Alderman Baker.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED 5/0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- A. Alderman Doehler discussed the need for the Rescue Squad's support in the Town of Greenback
- B. Mayor Birchfield discussed the funding request submitted by The Greenback Rescue Squad

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Alderman Black discussed having a Physician's Assistant potentially interested in leasing the old PPAWs building located at 6869 Morganton Rd.
- B. Mayor Birchfield discussed the state informing him that diverter valves are not permitted on the grinder pumps being installed with the sewer project and informed that the pipe supplier sent the wrong pipe size which slightly delayed the contractors working on the project.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. Mayor Birchfield informed that the HVAC unit at the old museum was damaged and had to be replaced.
- B. In consideration of the damage obtained from frequent heavy vehicles on Hutton Road, including a concern received in writing from the Town of Greenback's liability insurance provider, Alderman Doehler made a motion to create an ordinance for a weight limit on Hutton Road.
