MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dewayne Birchfield at 7:00pm.

ROLL CALL

Upon Roll Call, the following Board members were PRESENT: Tina Baker, Derrick Doehler, Delmar Davis, Linda Black and Dewayne Birchfield.

Thereupon, Mayor Dewayne Birchfield declared the presence of a quorum.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Black made a motion to adopt the March 10, 2026 Board Meeting Agenda. The motion was seconded by Alderman Baker.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED 4/0.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Black made the motion that the February 10, 2026 Board Meeting Minutes be accepted and approved as written. The motion was seconded by Alderman Doehler.

Upon Voice Vote, the motion PASSED 4/0.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Financial Statements for the month of February 2026 were presented to the Board for review of monthly revenue and expenditures. Aldermen Black made the motion that the February 2026 Financial Statements be accepted as presented. The motion was seconded by Aldermen Doehler.

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENTS

Tim McCarter discussed a recent public records request he had made as Public Safety Director as well as ongoing discussions in regard to the 911 board access for the Rescue Squad.

Joy LaForce spoke regarding consistent issues with quarry operation and clarity on zoning.

Clyde Franks spoke regarding issues with quarry blasting and operation.

BOARD COMMENTS

Alderman Davis spoke regarding political signage only being allowed on private property with permission from the property owner and any political signage on public property needs to be removed.

Alderman Black asked for clarity as to who the new tenants are that occupy 6889 Morganton Rd.

Alderman Doehler gave updates on bids and progress for the building to be build behind the Community Center and 6889 Morganton Rd.

Mayor Birchfield spoke regarding conversations he had with state law enforcement and representatives in reference to enforcement of the weight limit on Hutton Rd.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Mayor Birchfield thanked Mr. Moore and Mrs. Wampler for their donations toward the basketball goal which will be placed for use inside the pickleball court.
- B. Mayor Birchfield explained that due to another overflow of the downstairs restrooms the Community Center would have to move forward with sewer hookup and that septic repair was no longer an option.

NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion was held on where the situation was last left and that a member from Greenback Youth Sports was supposed to take plans for restrooms to Loudon County Planning and the board had not heard back since it was last discussed.

B. Mayor Birchfield explained that multiple roads within the Town limits needed small repairs and that those were underway and almost complete.

C. Discussion began for the potential of aiding in the paving cost for the large parking lot located in the middle of Downtown Greenback with the understanding that the Town of Greenback would have the ability to utilize the large lot during events and special occasions. This would have to be added to the new budget if it is decided. A vote will be held once a estimate is presented.

D. Alderman Doehler made a motion to accept Resolution 26-03-6 to set a date for an election to elect the Town of Greenback Mayor and four Aldermen on November 3, 2026. The motion was seconded by Alderman Baker.

Upon Roll Call Vote the following Board members voted AYE: Davis, Doehler, Baker, Black

The motion PASSED: (4/0)

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion made by Aldermen Doehler and seconded by Alderman Baker.
